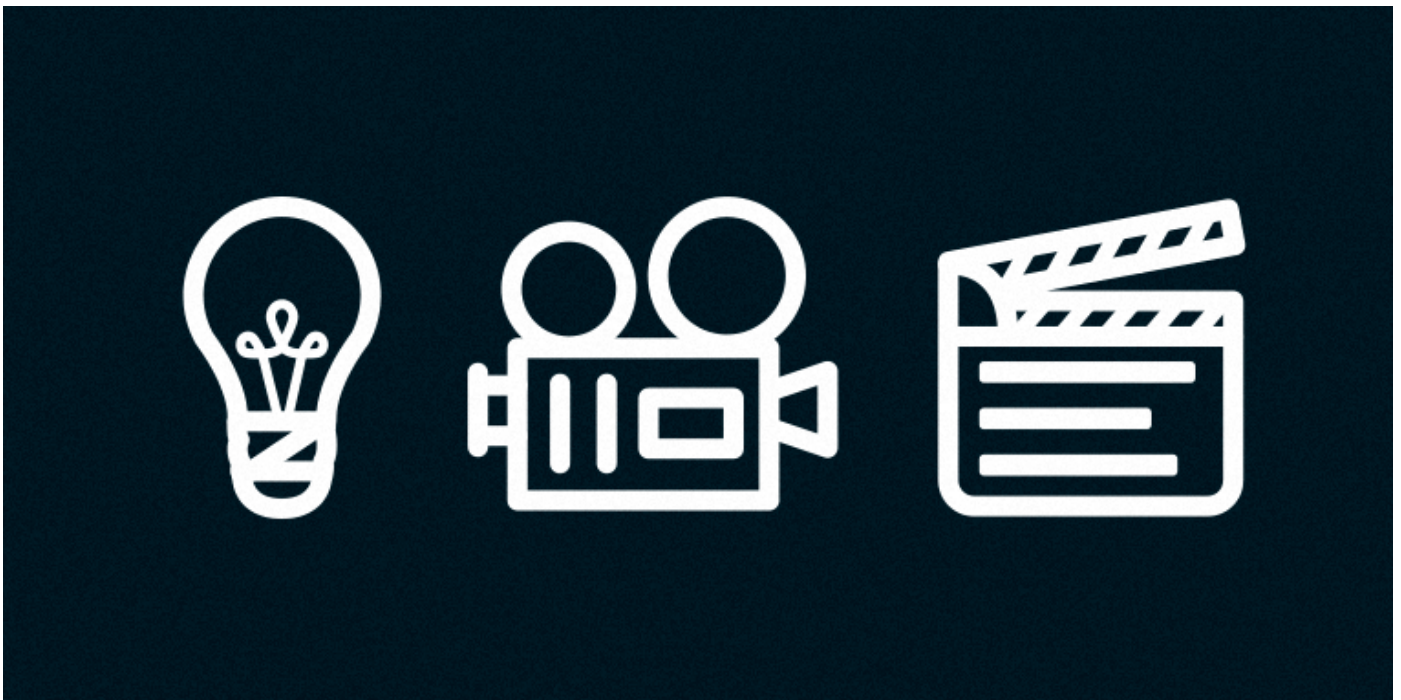

Online Teaching Videos

Online teaching is a great supplement for in-person instruction. It is an especially valuable tool when Children's Ministry Classes are unable to meet, such in the case of the Covid-19 pandemic. Putting together an online lesson can be time consuming and frustrating, but this process can be simplified by following the steps included in this workshop.

10 Things You Will Need

1. A Computer - iMac or PC
2. OBS Software download for computer - www.obsproject.com
3. OBS App for smartphone - App Store or Google Play
4. Smartphone (if computer doesn't have a camera or smartphone camera is preferred).
5. Green Screen - Foam core board & paint or amazon.com
6. Smartphone tripod - amazon.com (optional)
7. LED photography light - amazon.com (optional)
8. USB Microphone - amazon.com (optional)
9. 6' smartphone charging cable
10. Table, desk or podium (music stand)

Let's Make a Video!

Preparation

1. Eliminate noise and distractions. (fans, pets, tv, etc.)
2. Have a glass of water.
3. Printed lesson.
4. Record a 5-10 second test video.
 - Video is centered with no “green screen” haze.
 - Audio is clear with no feedback and volume is adjusted properly.

Set-Up

1. Green Screen



2. Smart phone, tripod, light and microphone connected to iMac or PC

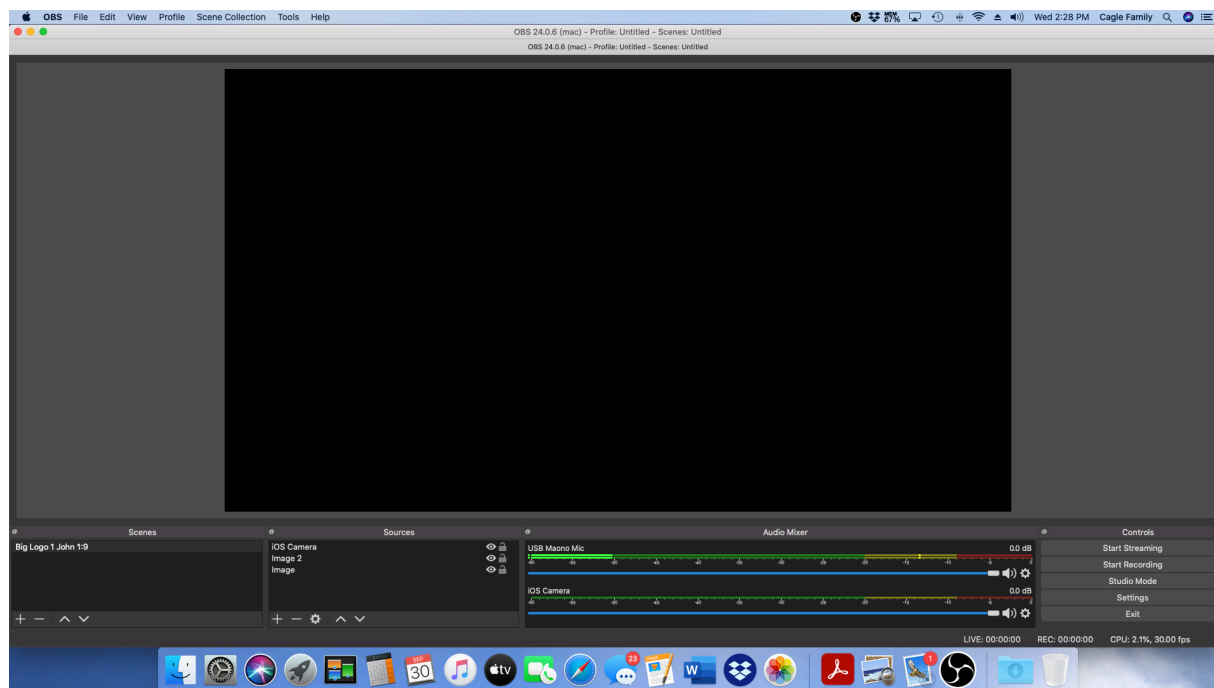


Recording the Video

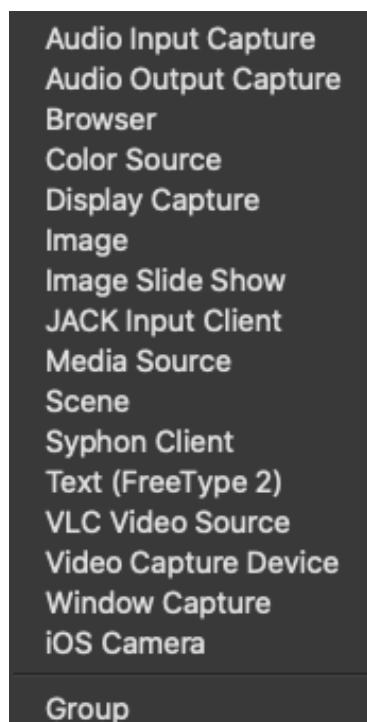
- Open up OBS on iMac or PC



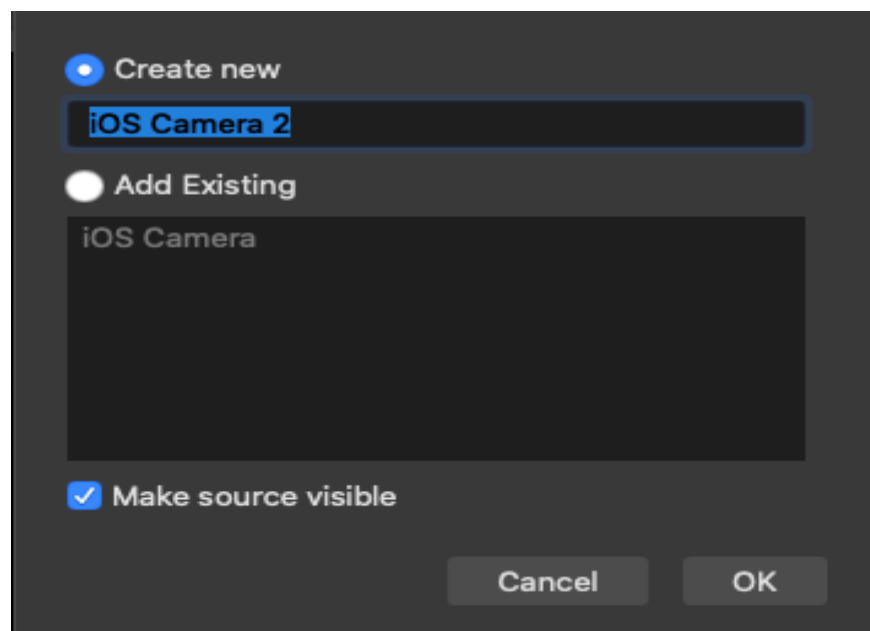
- OBS Home Screen



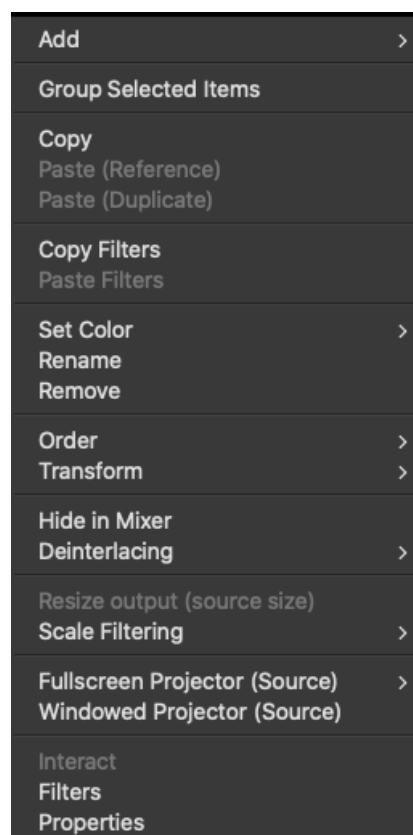
- Press “+” under “Sources” and choose camera



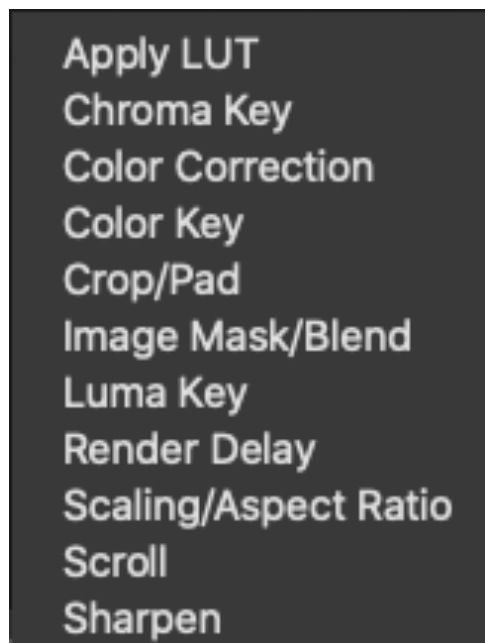
- Add Camera



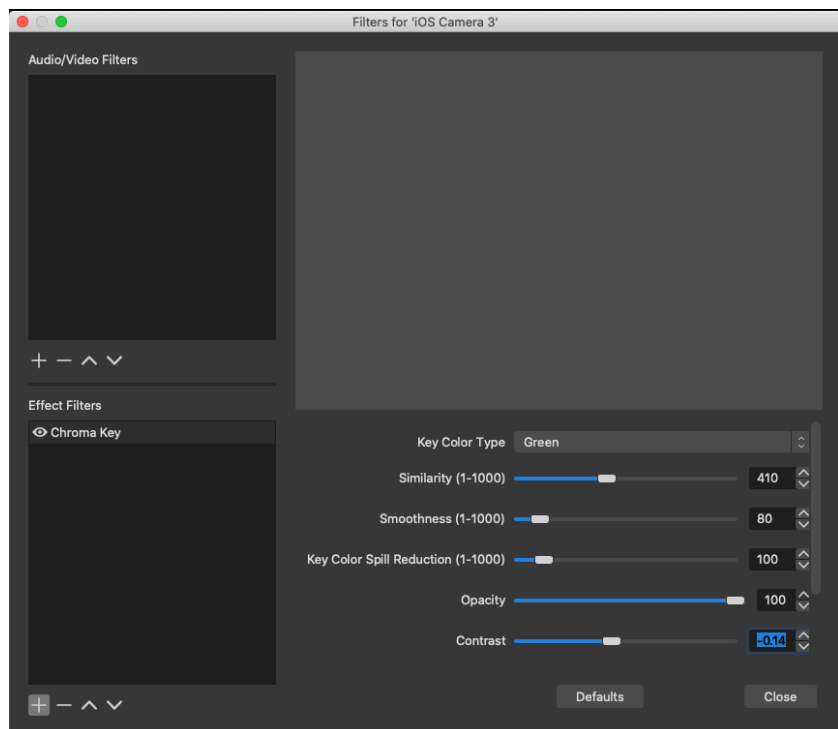
- "Right click" on Filters



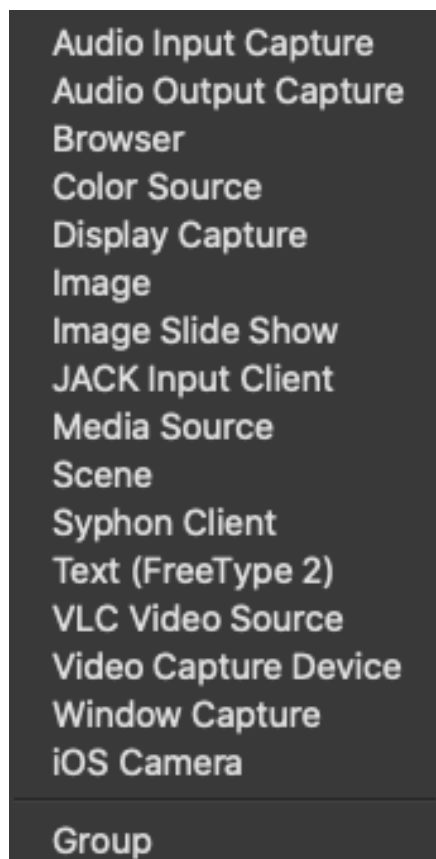
- Chose “Chroma Key”



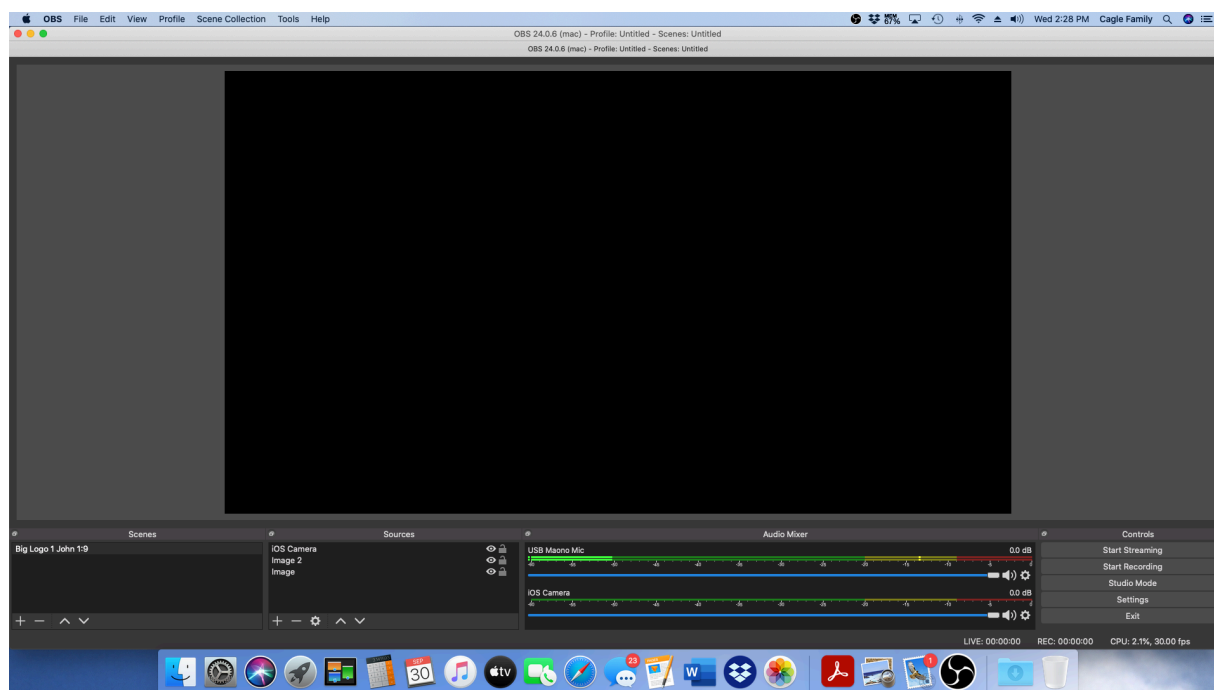
- Adjust Chroma Key Settings



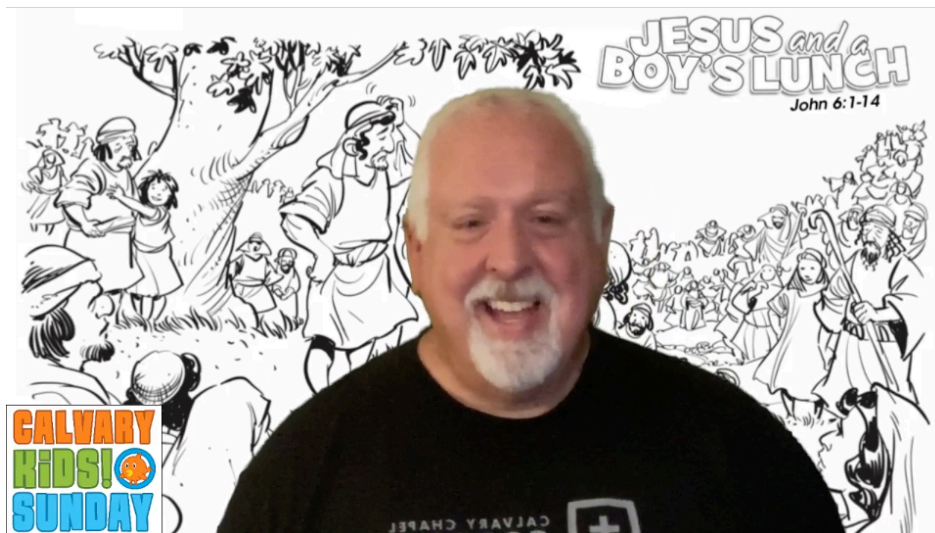
- Add an Image



- Return to OBS Home Screen to adjust image placement

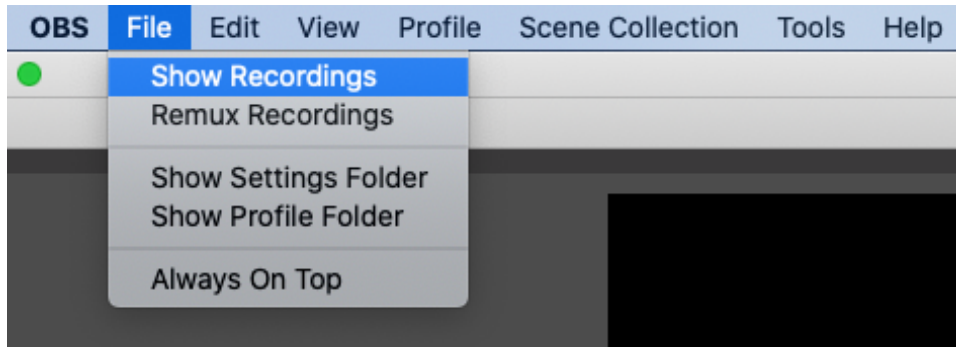


- Resizing Images & Image Placement

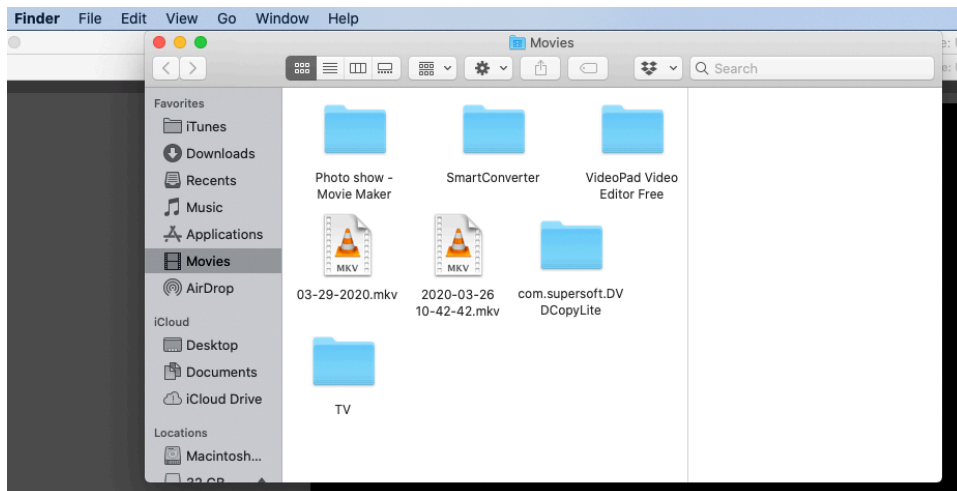


Publishing the Video

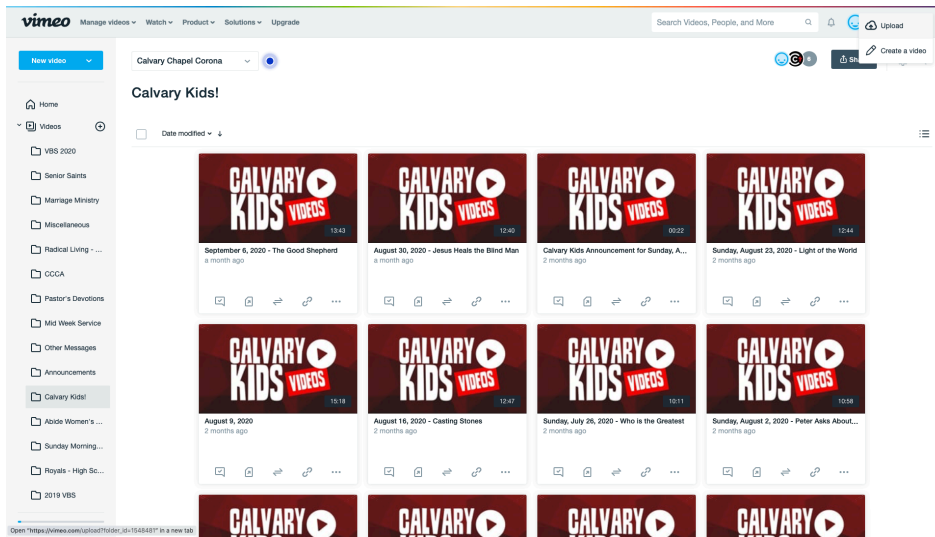
- Go to Recordings



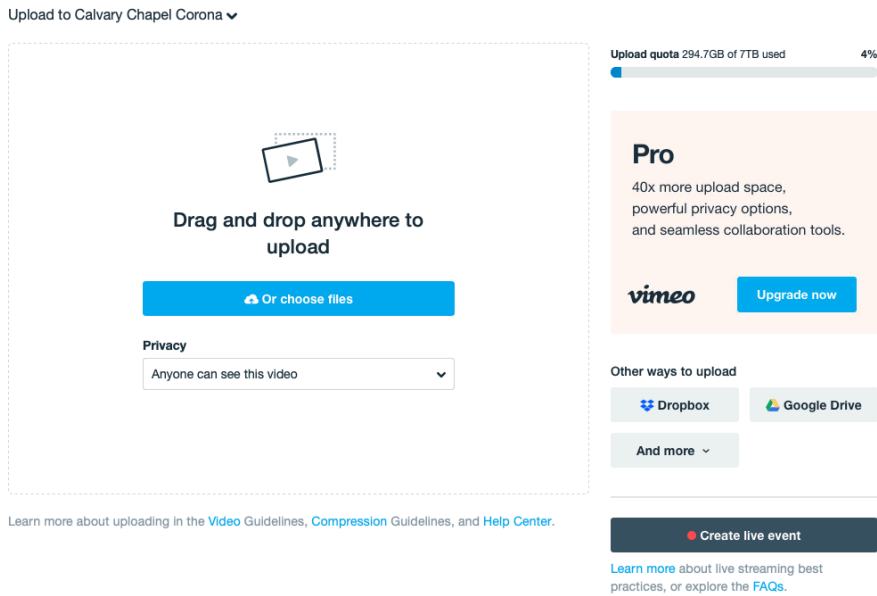
- Choose recording and “Drag” to desktop



- Rename recording
- Sign into Vimeo account.
- Choose New Video and Upload
- Changing the thumbnail.



- Choose file to upload (Desktop)



Tips

- If using an external USB mic, mute mic on computer.
- If using a phone to record video, use as “Forward facing.”
- Make sure ONLY the green screen is in the frame.
- Don’t wear anything with the color green or teal.
- Turn off ceiling fans or anything that would add noise to your recording.
- Always record a 5-10 second “Test” video and delete it.
- Don’t chew gum.
- Keep good eye contact with the camera.

Experiment and be creative!
