WHAT IS APOLOGETICS?

- Apologetics comes from the Greek word "apologia" meaning "speaking in defense"
- Apologetics answers the "why" questions of Christianity
- **1 PETER 3:15**- But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;

WHY APOLOGETICS IN CHILDREN'S MINISTRY?

- Apologetics equips students
 - Gives kids answers to the big and real questions they are asking (asking questions is a part of learning)
 - Helps kids build a firm foundation in their walk with God, knowing their faith is founded upon fact
 - Provides tools for kids to share their faith and disciple others
- Apologetics equips teachers
 - Provides teachers with tools to teach kids and answer their questions
 - Helps teachers to be confident and grow in their own personal walk with God
