My Goals:

Monday

- Memorize weekly Bible verse/prayer time daily
 - Apply verse to student's life.
 - Use questions: tell me a command to obey, state a sin I should avoid, show me a good example to follow, tell me a bad example to avoid, give me a promise, warn me about something

Tuesday

- Word Search
 - Use vocabulary to discuss the meanings of key words that will be used in the Bible study
- Scripture reading
 - Use yellow pencil to highlight key thoughts as you read the passage with your students. Use application questions for discussion.

Wednesday

- Continue Bible study
 - Utilize word search and review scripture reading.
 - Bible study worksheet to find the answers.

Thursday - weekly Chapel service

- Bible journal created by each student

Friday

- Bible test: verses (graded) and apply to your life (not graded).
 - Color page: review Bible story and how it applies to your life.
- Games in the Classroom...Matt Enterline*

Considerations:

- Learn the books of the Bible at the beginning of the school year.
 - Poster on Calvary Curriculum Academy
 - Review daily

- Set time aside to teach attributes of God (ex. He is trustworthy, honest, kind, protector, etc.) and model how to pray using the attributes of God.

- Establish worship time. I utilized North Point Kids music and others on You Tube.

- Opening each day included: pledges, Bible verse, share with a buddy your application, review books of the Bible, worship time (some days we rotated books of the Bible and worship).

- View Little Ones Curriculum to interchange worksheets.

- Students teach the Bible lesson.

- Student have private quiet time: memorize Bible verse, make application, pray
