



Is this legal? Yes! In 2001, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled in *Good News Clubs v. Milford Central School* that Good News Clubs can meet in public schools in the United States after school hours on the same terms as other community groups. Children attend Good News Club only with parental permission. The purpose of Good News Club is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and establish them in the Word of God and in a local church for Christian living. Currently, 80% of the children attending are unchurched. There's over 50 Good News Clubs taking place in the local area.
