



Things to remember about the word “Dinosaur” not showing up in the Bible:

- The Bible was translated into English in 1611 from Hebrew, Aramaic, and Greek.
- The word DINOSAUR was not invented until 1841.
- Since the word dinosaur was not invented until 230 years after the KJV of the Bible was translated it won't show up in the Bible.
- The word DRAGON was the word that was used up until 1841 to describe dinosaur like creatures.

The Bible mentions dinosaurs-like creatures:

- 5 key words in Hebrew/Greek that refer to DINOSAURS/DRAGONS that take place AFTER the flood except the first Bible verse in *Genesis 1:21.



Other things to remember:

- The Bible was originally written in Hebrew, Greek, and Aramaic. When the words are translated into English sometimes the wrong words can be applied to the translation such as in the case of the Hebrew word “tannîyn” being translated as a “jackal.” Unfortunately many modern translations of the Bible wrongly translate “tannîyn” as “jackal” even though the ancient Hebrew plural word for jackal is “tannim” and not “tannin.” Close in spelling, but still a different word. Unfortunately even translators have bias and make mistakes. So, a bias towards dinosaurs living with man have affected the translations. But, the Bible, in its original manuscripts, is perfect and without error. Reading the **King James** translation of the Bible you will find the word “tannîyn” more accurately translated.
- The word “drákōn” is the Greek word chosen to describe Satan in Revelation. Would God use imagery of a dragon for Satan IF dragons never existed? NOWHERE in scripture does God describe someone/something using a fake creature.
