JESUS Sees ZACCHAEUS



QUICK OVERVIEW: A rich tax collector named Zacchaeus wanted to see Jesus. But he could not because the crowd was large and he was short, so he climbed a sycamore tree. When Jesus looked up and saw Zacchaeus, He said, "Come down, I am going to your house." At the house, Zacchaeus repented of stealing and promised to give back what he had stolen. Jesus responded, "Today salvation has come to this house."

KEY VERSE: "For the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost." Luke 19:10



QUESTION: Why did Jesus choose to "see" Zacchaeus?

LUKE 19:1-10: ¹ And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho. ² And, behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the [tax collectors], and he was rich. ³ And he sought to see Jesus who He was; and could not for the [crowd], because he was little of stature. ⁴ And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycomore tree to see Him: for He was to pass that way. ⁵ And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for today I must abide at thy house. ⁶ And he made haste, and came down, and received Him joyfully. ⁷ And when they saw it, they all murmured, saying, That He was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner. ⁸ And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. ⁹ And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsoomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. ¹⁰ For the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.




