PRINCIPLE 1

- **Seek the Lord first
about everything.**



SEEK THE LORD

Proverbs 3:5–6

***Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
And lean not on your own
understanding;***

***In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He shall direct your paths.***



SEEK THE LORD

Jeremiah 29:11-13

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.

PRINCIPLE 2

- **Love the Lord with all
your heart.**

Matthew 22:37–40

PRINCIPLE 4

- **Be filled with the Holy Spirit.**



BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

Acts 1:4–5

4 And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” He said, “you have heard from Me; 5 for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

PRINCIPLE 5

➤ **Keep the unity.**



KEEP THE UNITY

Ephesians 4:1–3

4 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, 2 with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, 3 endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.



➤ **Keep the unity**

- Lowliness (humility)
- Gentleness
- Long-suffering (bearing with others)

20 Then Peter, turning around, saw the disciple whom Jesus loved following, who also had leaned on His breast at the supper, and said, “Lord, who is the one who betrays You?”

21 Peter, seeing him, said to Jesus, “But Lord, what about this man?”

22 Jesus said to him, “If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you? You follow Me.” -John 21:20–22



PRINCIPLE 6

➤ **Stick to the Bible.**



STICK TO THE BIBLE

1 Timothy 4:6

6 If you instruct the brethren in these things, you will be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed.

STICK TO THE BIBLE

Acts 20:26–28

26 Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all men.

27 For I have not shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God.

28 Therefore take heed to yourselves and to all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

PRINCIPLE 7

- **Emphasize relationship with Jesus**



EMPHASIZE RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.



EMPHASIZE RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS

Philippians 3:8–11

8 Yet indeed I also count all things loss for the excellence of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith; 10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, 11 if, by any means, I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

PRINCIPLE 8

➤ **Organize**



ORGANIZE

Mark 6:39–40

39 Then He commanded them to make them all sit down in groups on the green grass. 40 So they sat down in ranks, in hundreds and in fifties.

ORGANIZE

Exodus 18:21–22

21 Moreover you shall select from all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens. 22 And let them judge the people at all times. Then it will be that every great matter they shall bring to you, but every small matter they themselves shall judge. So it will be easier for you, for they will bear the burden with you.

ORGANIZE

John 10:11–12
